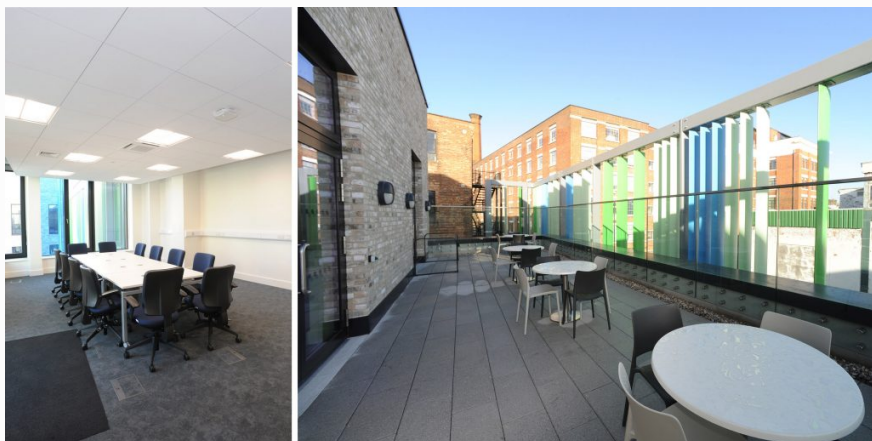

### MAIN WORKSHOP

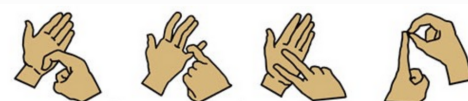
- Deaf residents will meet with key council staff
